



國外教授來訪學術演講「American foreign policy towards Taiwan」

Mr. Ross Feingold was invited as a guest speaker in the American Foreign Policy Course to present his standpoint on the recent US Presidential elections in general and their implication to US-China and US-Taiwan relations in particular. During his speech, Mr. Feingold discussed various topics, including, inter alia, multilateralism and international organizations/agreements, climate change, security and arms sales. In the context of US' relations with China and Taiwan, Mr. Feingold stated that while the Biden administration might change some of Trump' s policies (e.g. hard on China, pro-Taiwan), there are a few factors that can limit Biden' s room for maneuverer. This is definitely the case in regards to changes that require congressional support. Finally, in the Q&A section, Mr. Feingold answers students' questions regarding the possibility of Chinese invasion to Taiwan, US-Taiwan MOUs, and the impact of the American trade policies on Taiwan' s semi-conductor industry.
